Sign of the Cross:

All: In the name of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Apostles' Creed:

All: I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

Our Father: for the intentions of our Holy Father

Leader: Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Leader: Hail Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

All: Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Third Joyful Mystery: *(at beginning of decade)*

Leader: Lord Jesus, we offer You this third decade to honor Your Birth in the stable at Bethlehem, and we ask of You, through this Mystery and through the intercession of Your Holy Mother, sincere love of God.

Fourth Joyful Mystery: *(at beginning of decade)*

Leader: Lord Jesus, we offer You this fourth decade to honor Your Presentation in the Temple and the Purification of Mary, and we ask of You, through this Mystery and through the intercession of Your Holy Mother, a great spirit of sacrifice.

Fifth Joyful Mystery: *(at beginning of decade)*

Leader: Lord Jesus, we offer You this fifth decade to honor Your Finding in the Temple, and we ask of You, through this Mystery and through the intercession of Your Holy Mother, zeal for God's glory.
